Annual MESMAC International Conference

MESMAC International conference was initiated in 2016 as a Golden Jubilee platform in which cross-disciplinary dialogues are made possible, involving thought leaders, academics, and scholars. It was conceived to take the academic endeavors and reach of the institution to the next level. With the four previous editions, the global scale conferences have been established as the leading college conference in South India. Leading thinkers, writers, scientists, statesmen, and community leaders visited the campus to interact with the young generation to lead and empower them. Over the last 6 editions of the conference, we have hosted 100 speakers, presented 1300 papers and published 22 books with ISBN.
