# ANNUAL REPORT

The current strength of students in our college is 2829, out of which 1878 are girls. The college offers 18 UG programmes, One Integrated PG, 8 PG, and 5 PhD programmes. The first-year PG class was begun on 24 Aug. 2022 and UG on 25 Aug. 2022. The induction program for first-year students was held from 25-8-2022 to 31-08-2022, and inaugurated by Sri Mohandas IAS (Former district collector Malappuram). Presently, 117 faculty members are working in this college out of which 66 belong to Government aided programmes. Dr Vinod Kumar was promoted and transferred to MES KVM College Valanchery as Principal. The college performs excellent academic records in autonomous examinations. The average pass percentage is 84.41 in UG and 87.59 in PG. Two open defenses of Ph.D. Scholars conducted this academic year. Mr Divin Murukesh under the guidance of Dr Anoop Das and Mr. Sulfi under the guidance of Dr Vinod Kumar.

Eight faculty members conferred Doctoral degrees in this academic year, they are Mr Jamsheer A M, Mr Anas E, Lt. Shameer Babu. Mr Basheer P T, Mr Sulfi P. Ms Nasiya V K, Ms Jeemol, and Ms Sumitha Paul.

The new administrative block which is partially assisted by RUSA started functional in this academic year. An open classroom was built in the campus this year. The work of the new library block is progressing in a faster pace.
