
### Stakeholder Feedback Analysis Report 2018-19

A total of 625 students gave their feedback. The analysis of feedback is given below




### Analysis of Structured Feedback From Teachers 2018-19


A total of 61 Teachers gave their feedback. The analysis of feedback is given below




### Analysis of Structured Feedback From Employers 2018-19

### Analysis of Structured Feedback From Alumni 2019


Structured feedback on the curriculum was collected from the Alumni in the following areas.

### DEPARTMENT OF ARABIC ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK 2018-2019

The feedback from alumni suggested recommended including the relevant and novel courses in the new syllabus to enhance the employability, skill development and entrepreneurship of students, and it is suggested also to focus upon more practical papers for PG students. The Alumni suggested to incorporate the Internship programme in order to get industrial exposure, job experience and to prepare for future employment and building confidence. The students suggested to conduct Field visit to pioneer Arabic Departments of Universities to get academic exposure of well known Institutions.

### DEPARTMENT ECONOMICS ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK 2018-2019

The feedback from alumni suggested the paper research methodology put in the third semester is more appropriate for doing project work in the fourth semester. Students also suggested this change. Teachers suggested improving research aptitude interchanging of research methodology paper from fourth to third is more appropriate since Project work of the students started in the third semester itself, this change will be very useful.

## DEPARTMENT ENGLISH ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK 2018-2019

In Alumni feedback, they suggested that more seminars, conferences and invited lectures should be organized. As per this suggestion the topic was included in the agenda of the BoS meeting held on December 2019. Board discussed and approved the topics on which the lecture series are to be organized, namely—An Introduction to Film Studies, How to Read a Film, and Why Should We Learn" Literature. 1The Board discussed and approved the decision to organize an International Conference. A team with a coordinator was selected for the purpose.

#### **DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY**

### ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK 2018-2019

On the basis of feedback from students the Department suggested a change in Elective Paper. History of Human Rights and the BoS approved Indian Epigraphy as the Elective. Also revised the syllabi of paper 'Informatics and History'

## DEPARTMENT OF MASS COMMUNICATION AND JOURNALISM ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK 2018-2019

The feedback from alumni suggested that adding a paper titled Research Methodology will be really beneficial for doing their project work in the sixth semester. Students also suggested this change. Teachers also found this suggestion will be really helpful for the students to do their research work. The students' feedback also suggested starting a short term course apart from curriculum for appearing competitive exams. Teachers and different stakeholders are also suggested clearing a Competitive exam will help a person to enter into his Dream College or institution or to pursue his dream job.

# DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK 2018-2019

Collected feedback from students, parents, and teachers. Teachers suggested the inclusion of CSIR level questions in PG question bank and JAM level questions in UG question bank. PG students pointed out the necessity of installing chemdraw software in research lab so that they can draw the structure of molecules as instructed in the syllabus. Teachers and students demanded more time and shifting of fourth semester PG examination to ensure the completion of project works of students in institutes like NIISTs in systematic manner. Students demanded special supplementary exams for fifth semester papers at the time of sixth semester to avoid the lapse of one year.

## DEPARTMENT OF FOOD TECHNOLOGY FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2018-2019

Teachers suggested for adding research methodology paper for the PG students to enrich their knowledge and to enhance their research skills. Teachers also suggested in undertaking the PG project works in reputed institutions. Students made some request to perform their final year internships from out of the country too. Alumni showed their interest to conduct some career specific programmes associating with department. Students suggested to conduct field trips in each semesters in accordance with the course of study. The feedback from alumni suggested to conduct HACCP Training for the final year students. As per the feedback from the stakeholders, it is decided to organise bridge course in coming years too.

## DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK 2018-2019

Students suggested that more recent updated be added to the UG syllabus, courses in collaboration with partner universities are needed. Alumni has suggested providing more advanced and application level instructional strategies apart from the theoretical way of study. The employers suggested to implement the certificate course, which will ensure maximum employability. Teachers suggested to include new topics. According to the opinion and recommendation of the stakeholders we had revised the U G syllabus. Since we received overwhelming response, we decided to continue the short term course 'Programming in python' for this academic year also.

# DEPARTMENT PHYSICS ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK 2018-2019

According to the feedback provided by the students and teachers, the internal evaluation system was introduced with mandatory seminar presentations, and a class was held to introduce students to career prospects and higher studies.

## DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK 2018-2019

As per the student feedback the introduced new elective course was successfully implemented to the students. This paper will give some employability to the students. The same certificate course also carried out this year also. Good response related with the previous certificate course gave motivation to start new courses. Due to the COVID situation review project was introduced as part of curriculum. Field observation note is also included in the syllabus for improving the observation skill.

## DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK 2018-2019

Based on the request from Teachers, It is decided to request to University to reduce syllabus in the coming syllabus. Based on the feedback from different stake holders, It is decided to go on with university syllabus from 2019 admission onwards and Decided to form a committee headed by Dr. Shahanas Beegum to identify the relevant portion of syllabus which they have already studied as well as the new area of development in the respective subject. The students, teachers and Industrialists suggested to introduce Industrial Visit to the BBA Students to get alive industrial Picture and based on those suggestions, The BoS Decided to conduct IV to the Second Year BBA Students. Based on the suggestions from Alumni and Teachers. Decided to conduct finishing School Programme
