Professional Development Cell in collaboration with SKY conducted a workshop on "Presentation Skills" on 17thjuly 2017.

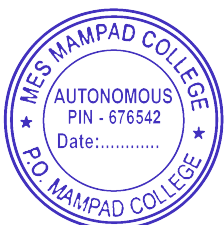
A Hands on training program was conducted by the Professional Development Cell on "Smart Board Interaction in Class rooms" on 20/07/2017 in PG seminar hall.
