MESMAC INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCES 2021

The fifth edition of MESMAC International Conference was conducted at MES Mampad College from 18th to 30th January 2021 in blended mode. The theme of the conference was “What Next: Challenges Opportunities Promises”. Since its launch in 2016, the MESMAC International Conference has come to set the bar in terms of quality and participation. The 2021 edition of the conference raised the benchmark further, by collaborating quality educational institutions in the country and abroad. Including this year, over 1300 papers presented and 20 books published with ISBN as part of the conference.

The Chief Patrons of the Conference were Dr. Fazal Ghafoor, President, MES, Dr POJ Lebba, General Secretary MES, Mr. EP Moyinkutty, President Management Committee and Mr. P H Muhammed, Chairman, Central College Committee, MES. Prof. OP Abdurahiman, Secretary, College Management Committee acted as the President. Prof. Anas E, Principal, MES Mampad College, chaired the Conference. A Team of seven faculty acted as coordinators.

Owing to the Covid-19 scenario, the conduct of the conference was de-centralized to various departments, and was organized in both online, offline and blended mode. Ms. Wafaa is the founder of the International Organization of Creativity for Peace. She was nominated for Nobel Prize in 2017 and 2019.

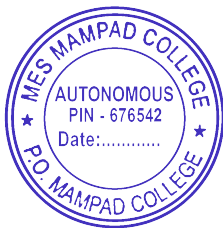
