#### REPORT ON THE TRAINING PROGRAM ON ENVIRONMENTAL SAMPLING, MONITORING AND CONSERVATION - 9th to 11th March 2022

M.E.S Mampad College, the largest Arts and Science College in Malappuram District have been recommended for autonomous status by the Kerala State Higher Education Council. The institution has recorded tremendous achievements in all aspects of higher education. The achievements were recognized by the apex bodies of institutional accreditation like NAAC. Mampad College was the first institution from Malappuram District to get NAAC accreditation as well as reaccreditation. It has been reaccredited with A grade with a Score of 3.5. The institution’s contribution to the educational history of Malabar is now part of history. It has brought a qualitative change in the lives of people especially from the backward and marginalized groups. The institution has a historic role in the educational and economic empowerment of people. This proactive role is one of the biggest strengths of the college.

MES Mampad College with the financial support from Directorate of Environment and Climate Change jointly organised an research oriented outreach program for the students to interact with an internationally well-known scientists to develop researchers academic as well as personal research skills.

During the three day program held on 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> March 2022 was a great success by the interaction with the 30 faculties, PhD scholars and students enrolled as well as young research scholars at the Centre for Conservation Ecology of the Department of Zoology. The sessions were greatly useful for the budding researchers to enhance their research thoughts and future plans. Most of the sessions were on hands on experience in the field of conservation Ecology. Research publication, scientific writing, global trends in the field of science and technology and research methodology preparation were the major topics elaborated and discussed in the sessions.

In the Inaugural session, Dr. Anoop Das briefed on the objective of the program to the participants along with the Zoology department faculty and the function was chaired by the Principal of the College Dr. Manzur Ali P.P. Prof. Dr. Sabu K Thomas, Principal, St. Joseph’s Devagiri College (Autonomous), Kozhikode interacted with the participants. He made an excellent talk and interaction on Fundamentals of insect Sampling, monitoring and conservation with Theory & Practical Sessions. The students as well as the faculty members of the department have actively participated and interacted with the scholar.

Second session was handled by Er. Balakrishnan Valappil, MNHS, Kozhikode Moths of Western Ghats along with Theory & Practical Sessions during the night time and that session was turned to one of the vibrant session because of the interaction of the participants.

On the second day, , Dr. Balakrishnan Peroth, Scientist, Division of Wildlife Biology, Kerala Forest Research Institute, Peechi deliberated on the topic 'Ecological Census- Technical methods for terrestrial vertebrates' in the third session. His research team made a commendable job by introducing all highly advanced equipment in the field of ecology. In the afternoon session Dr. Malik Fasil M, Assistant Professor, Department of Wildlife Science College of Forestry, Kerala Agricultural University handled a session on Forest Mensuration Techniques with Theory & Practical Sessions. A field trip was organised then to ensure to get the hand on experience to the researchers. He has made aware of most of the field techniques to the participants of the program.

Dr. A. Bijukumar, Professor and Head of the Department Aquatic Biology and Fisheries, University of Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram was the chief speaker of the third day on fifth session while handling a topic Sampling aquatic ecosystem for fishes. As there has been at least five research fellows who work on the fishes in the program, the session was quite informative and interactive. Dr. Bijukumar, elaborated on the need of such initiatives so as to monitor and catalogue the huge diversity of animals in the country.

Dr. C.C. Harilal, Associate Professor and Head, Division of Environmental Science, Department of Botany, University of Calicut have handled a session on Floristic sampling techniques and reiterated on the need for calculating Importance Value Index etc to the students. He also chaired the valedictory session and had distributed the certificates of the participants. The feed back session acknowledged the funding from DoECC, and participants have expressed their interest in the forthcoming program to be held at the college in future.

### **Women Development Cell**

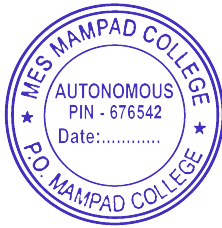


Govt. Law College Calicut on 04-12-2021 and 40 students from the college participated in it.
